## NOTIFICATION

On the recommendation of Enrolment Committee of Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners (Council), it is hereby notified that the graduates from all those institutions whose accreditation (architecture/ town planning) have been put "on hold" by the Council will have to undergo a Professional examination/test for acquiring Council's Registration. The said examination/test will be conducted by the Council. This condition shall apply only to those graduates who were declared qualified during "on hold" period by their respective institutions.

It is also to be noted that the Council does not approve transfer of credit hours (architecture/town planning) from a non-accredited to an accredited program. Following policy of the Council to be strictly followed by all institution's running architectural/town planning programs.

1. Transfer of credit hours shall only be transferred between chartered HEI's and Council's accredited programs.
2. Credit hours shall only be transferred from accredited to accredited program.
3. Transfer of credit hours from non-accredited to an accredited program is not allowed.
4. An undergraduate student seeking transfer from parent institution to new institution must be a regular student of the parent institution with 75% attendance on record and cleared all his compulsory core subjects as a pre condition for transfer.
5. Transferred undergraduate student must be enrolled as a regular student in the undergraduate program of the new institution and should earn a minimum of 100 credit hours from compulsory core subjects out of a total of 175 credit hours from the institution from where he/she will be entitled for the B.Arch degree and for the BS.CRP Degree a minimum of 80 credit hours from compulsory subjects out of a total of 134 credit hours from the new institution from where he/she will be entitled for BS CRP degree.
6. The information of transfer of undergraduate student form parent institution to new institution to be officially notified to the council by both the institutions for the council's record.

The Council shall not be responsible for any objection raised in future, as the graduating architects and town planners in violation PCATP policies will not be eligible for PCATP Registration.
